LYCIG

The last LYCIG gathering considered John 1 v35-42. This is where some of John the Baptist's disciples were gathered, Jesus walked by and some followed Jesus. Jesus immediately asked them what they were looking for and some responded, with Jesus then asking them to "Come and See". We considered what the passage meant, particularly in relation to what people see when they meet our church community or come to our churches? We were struck by the questions that demonstrated Jesus's interest in his followers, unlocking hidden needs. We saw that Jesus had time for them, that he lived in the moment, being present to his followers and giving them identity. How can we learn to follow Jesus's example? Perhaps by asking good questions of people we meet, having time for them, learning to enquire and inviting them to join in with our journey?
