On the Monday after Christmas, Adventist Yklas Kabduakasov was sentenced by Kazakhstan to two years in a labour camp for talking about Christianity. Despite 2015 seeing a significant rise in the numbers of prisoners of conscience and other human rights violations, the British government recently said it wants to be Kazakhstan's "partner of choice" and signed a £3bn trade deal with its President.
