**PLEASE PRAY FOR OUR MISSIONS:**



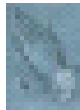
Please pray for the Damas de Blanco, or 'Ladies in White', in Cuba. Every Sunday they peacefully protest the unjust imprisonment of people who speak up for human rights. Dressed in white to symbolise peace, they attend Mass, then walk silently through the streets of their town or city. And for this they are arrested, harassed and beaten. One member, Caridad Caballero, had to flee Cuba in 2012 for fear of her life.

As they celebrate receiving The Queen's Award for Voluntary Service, let us pray for all the volunteers working with Mary's Meals in many different ways and in many different parts of the world. Let us pray that we, too, will find ways to help others in need by sharing our time, money and resources.



Pray for Kailean and Kim Khongsai, serving with CMS in Southall and Ealing, whose vision to transform derelict spaces is now bearing fruit, literally and spiritually. 54 tonnes of rubbish were shifted, 100 local people joined in planting 60 trees, 100+ fruit trees, a sensory garden and food growing area. Community support grows in funding and volunteering, and other churches want to start similar projects.
